VOTE: 5-0-2 (new member Dan Rissi & Jody Nazarchyk abstained)

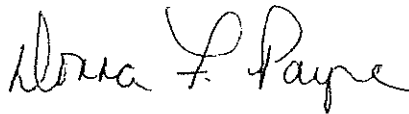
