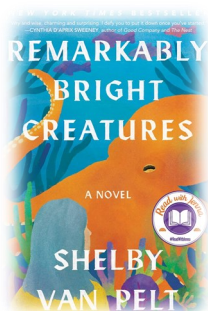

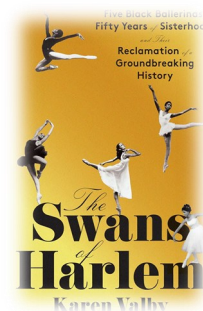

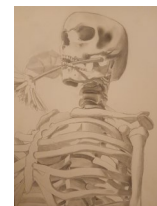
Family Movie Matinee
