

MOORING/ PULLEY POLE INSPECTIONS

Moorings shall be inspected by a qualified, approved inspector at least once every three years. Pulley Poles must be inspected every year. A copy of the inspection **MUST** be sent with your mooring application in order to be approved.

TO BE COMPLETED BY AN APPROVED MOORING INSPECTOR**

- All moorings within Waterford waters require permits, which must be renewed on an annual basis.
- All moorings shall be inspected by an approved mooring inspector **at least once every three (3) years**.
- No mooring gear should be installed without prior approval by the Waterford Harbor Master.
- Inspectors are responsible for providing a signed copy of the inspection form to the permittee.
