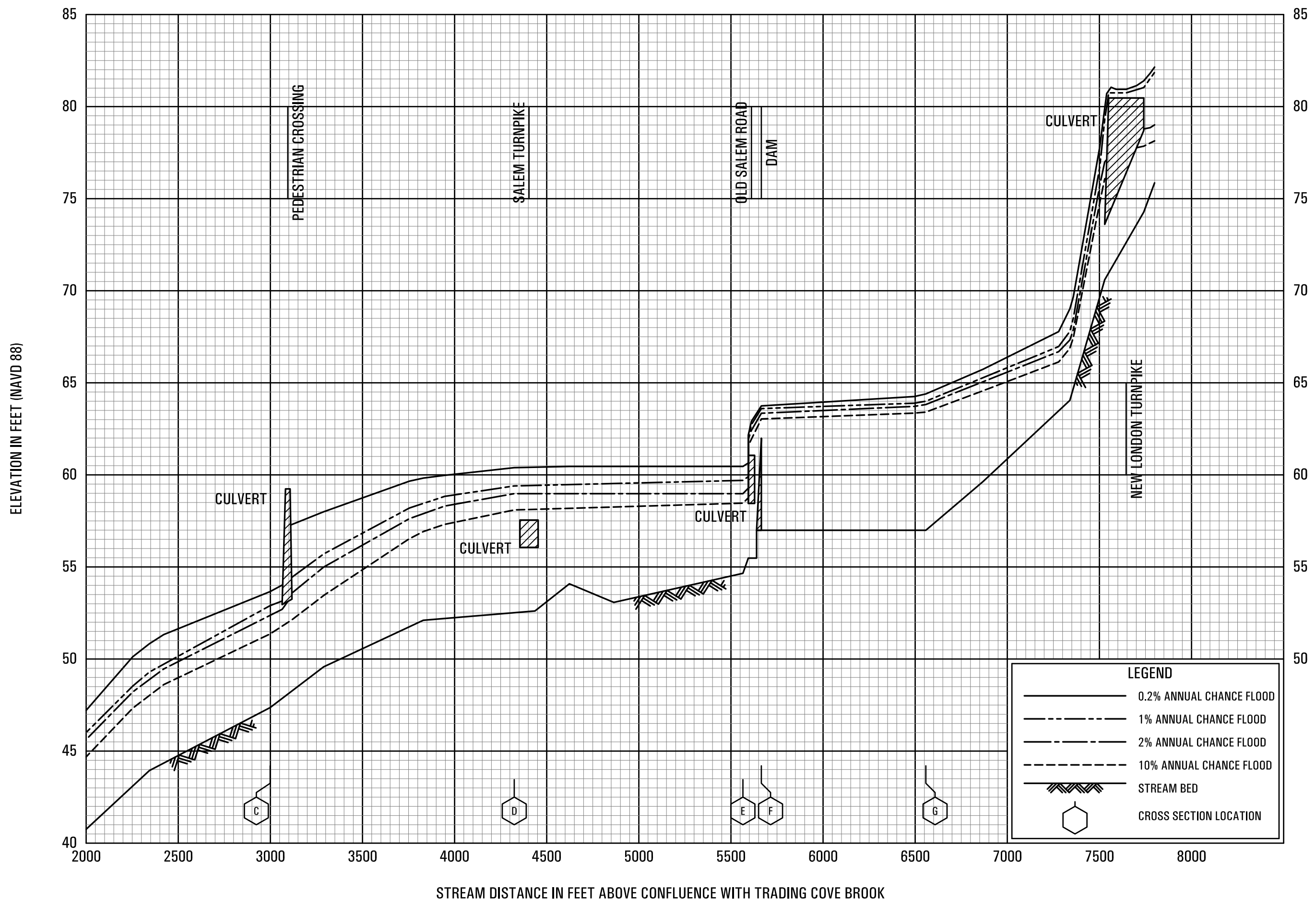
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STREAM DISTANCE IN FEET ABOVE CONFLUENCE WITH TRADING COVE BROOK

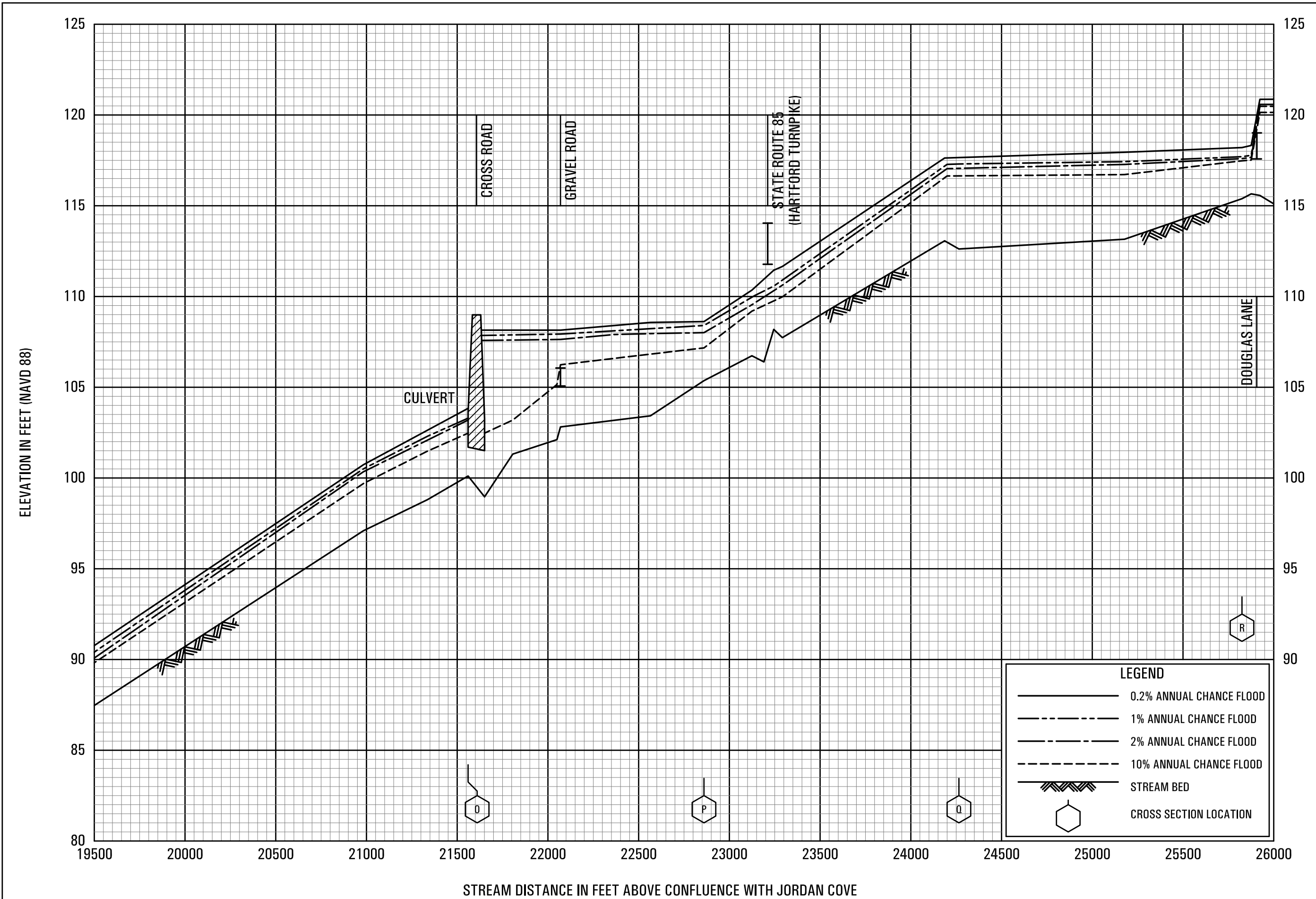


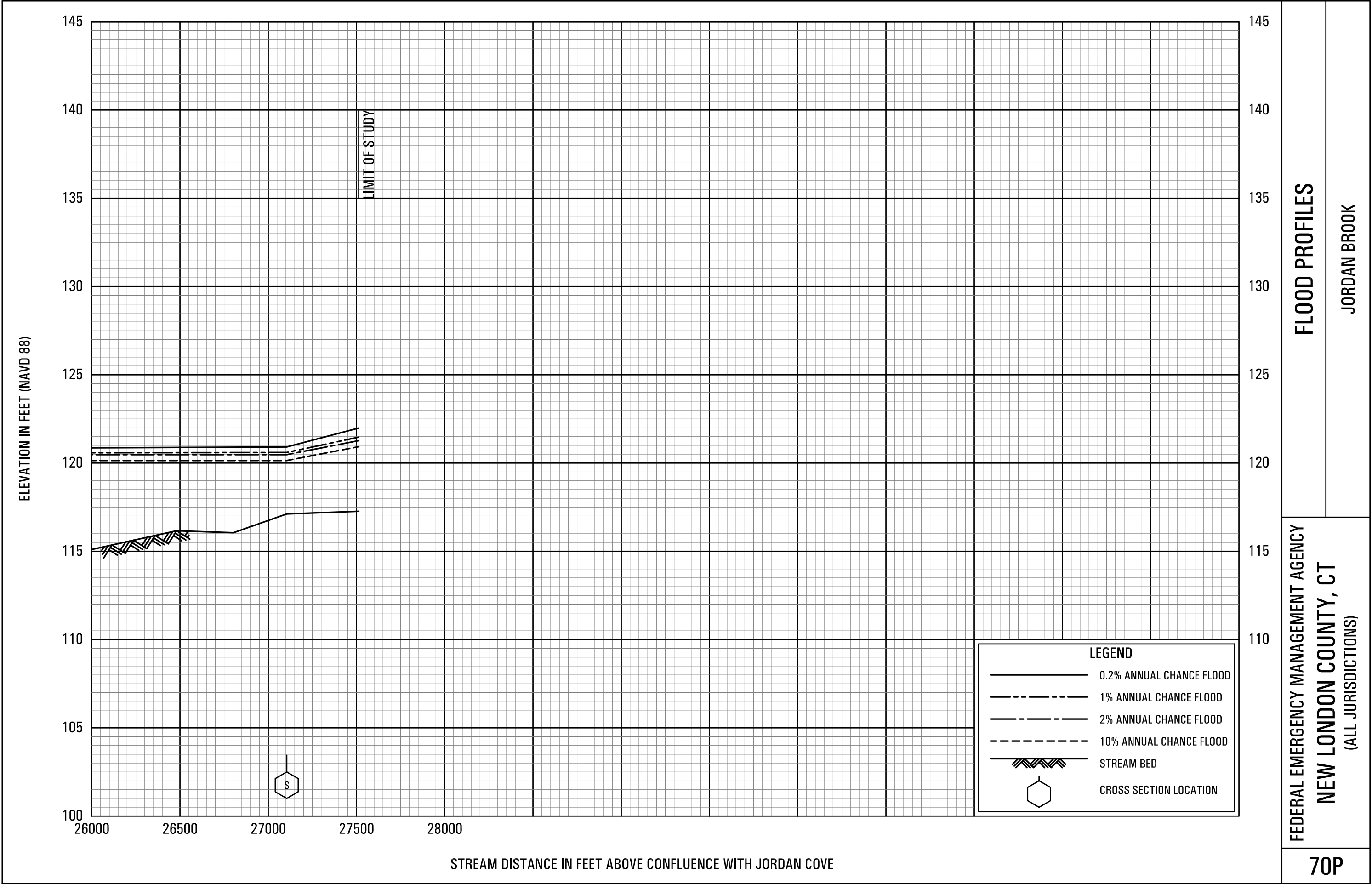


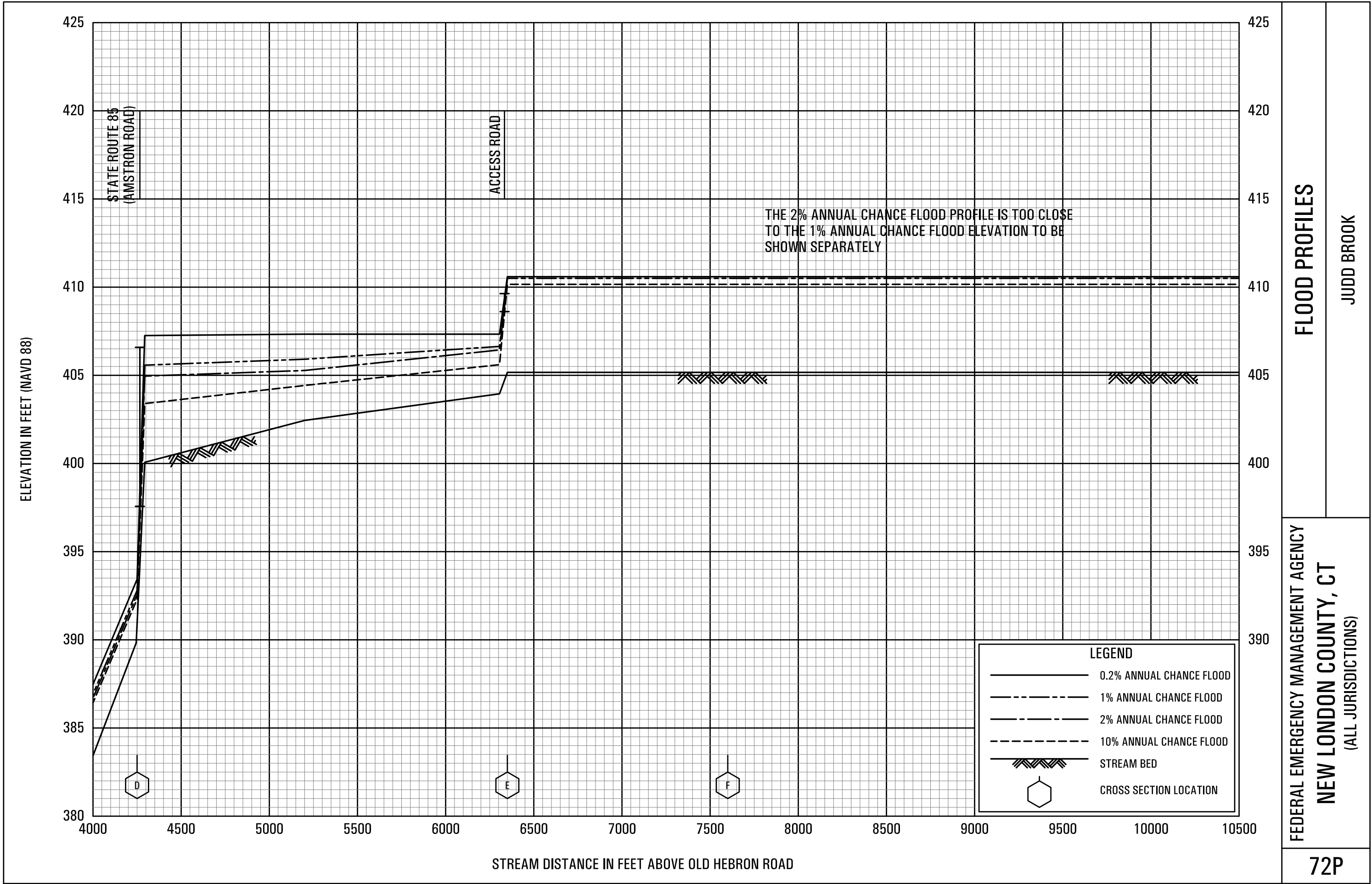
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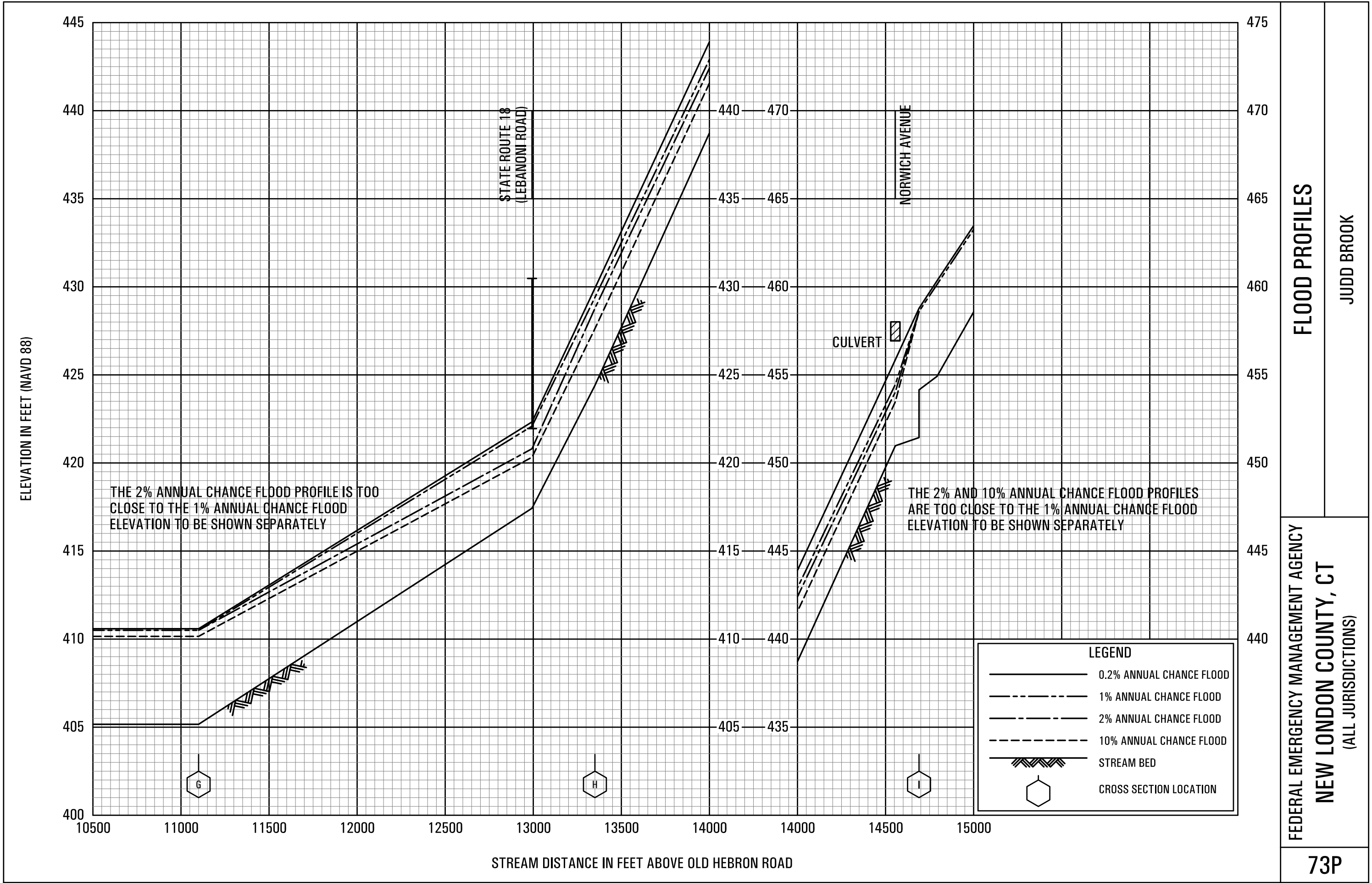
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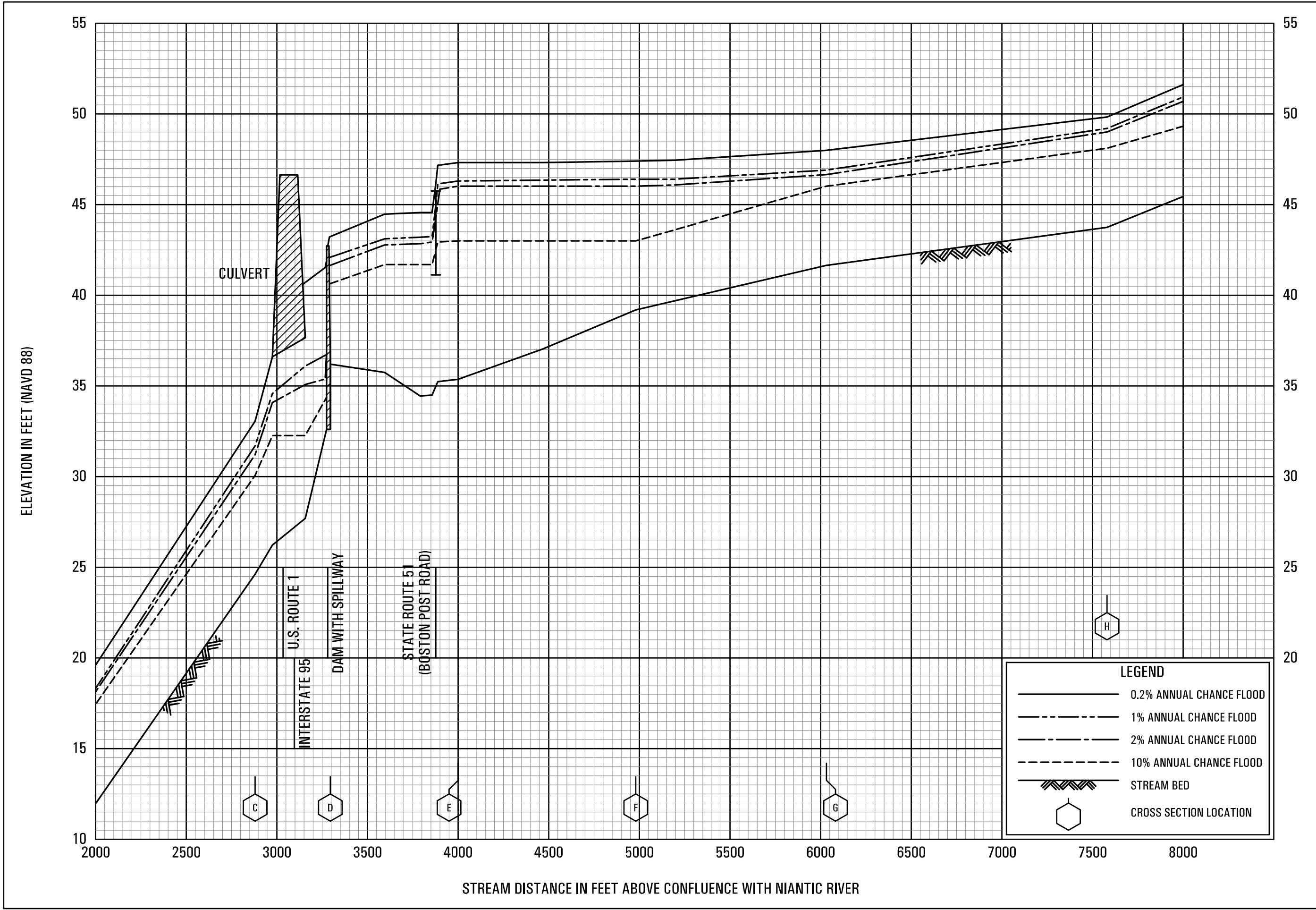
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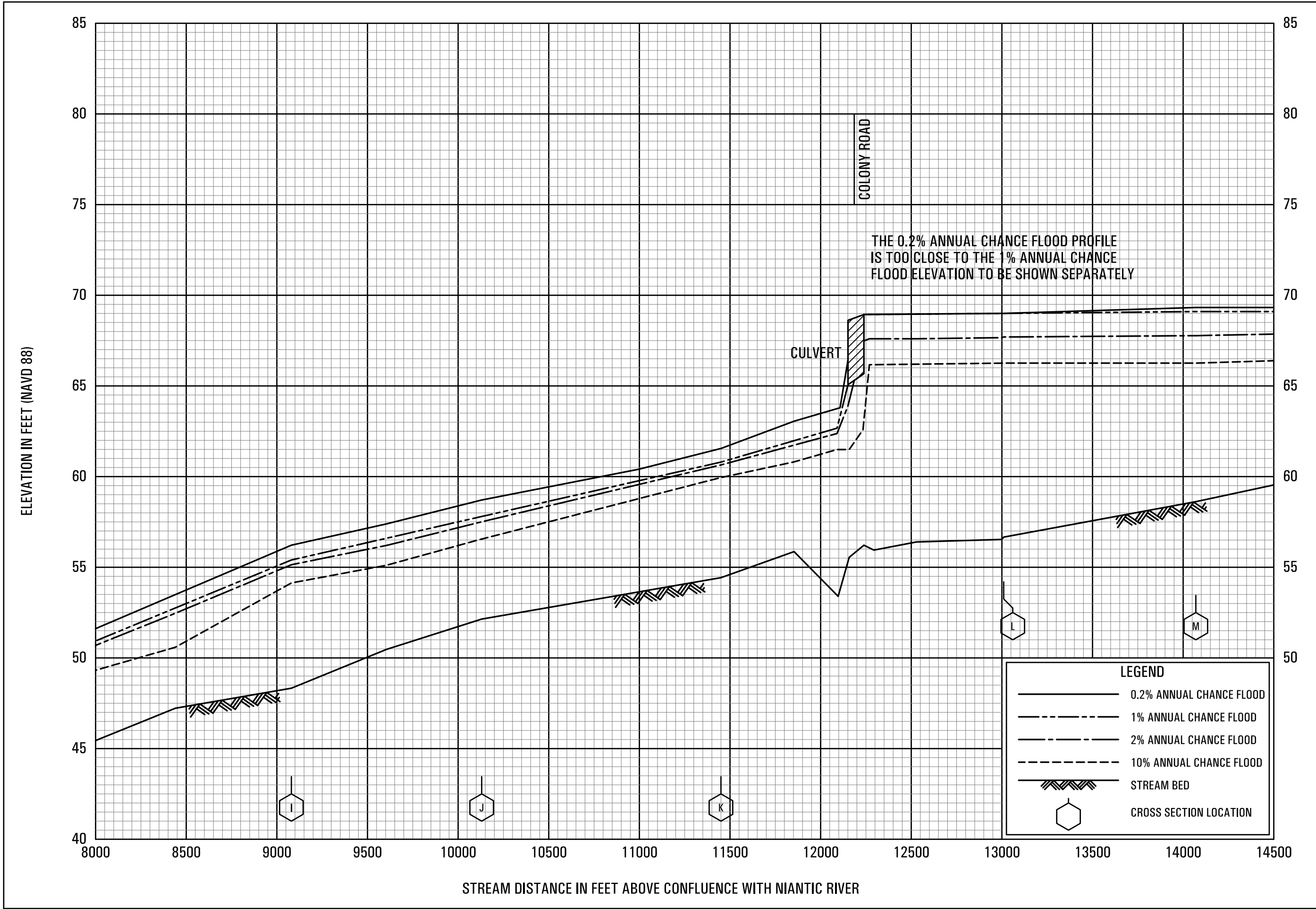


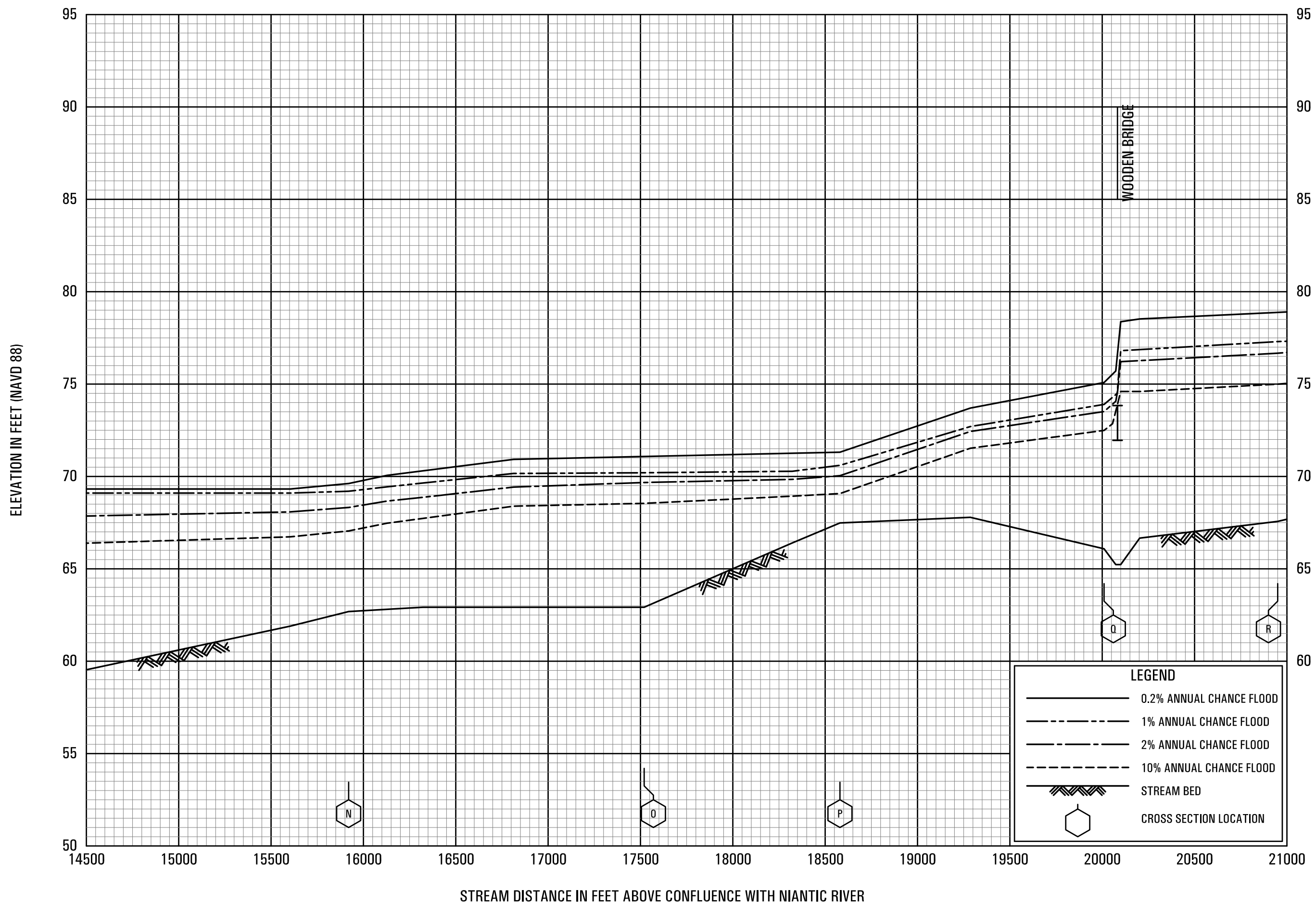












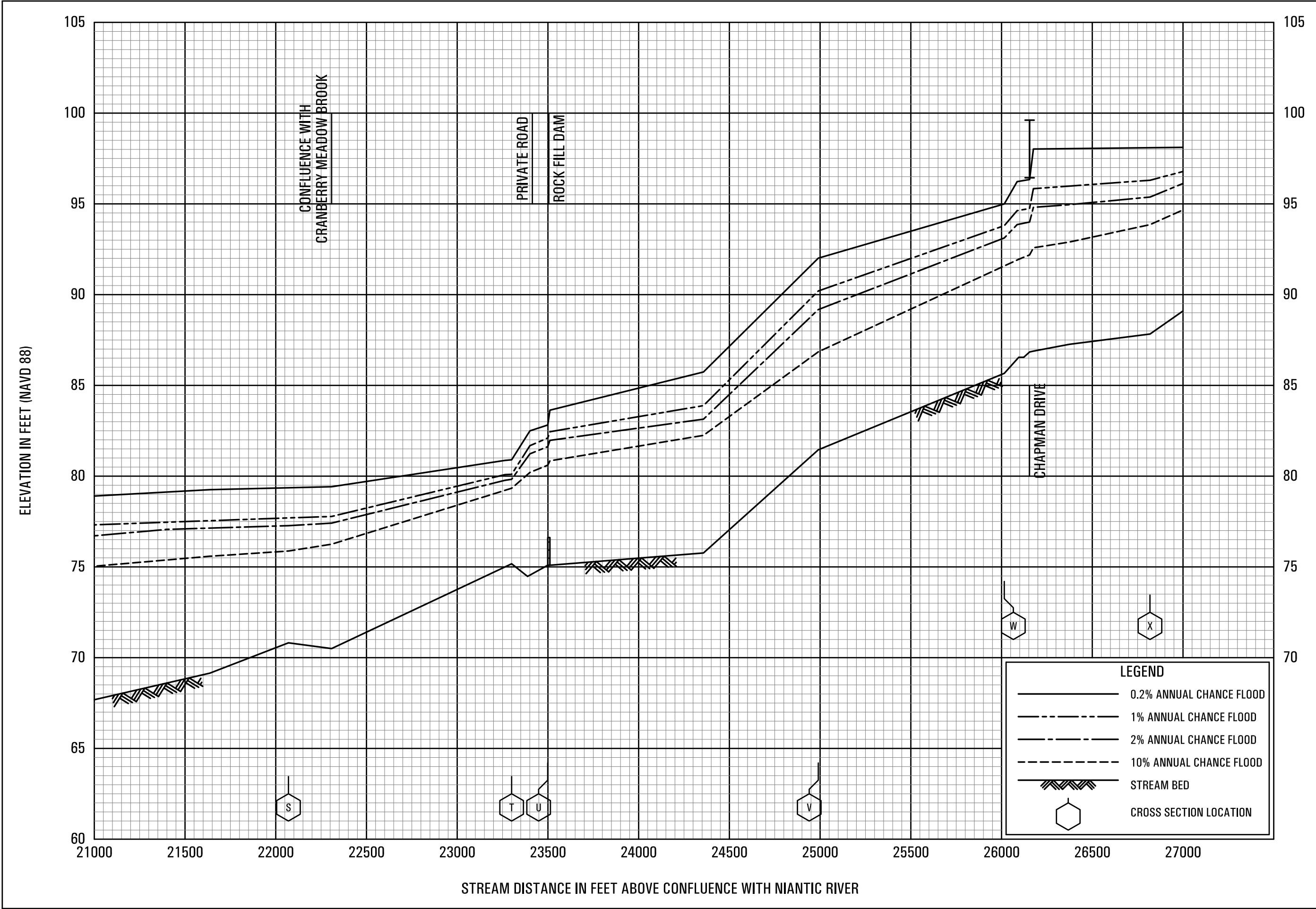
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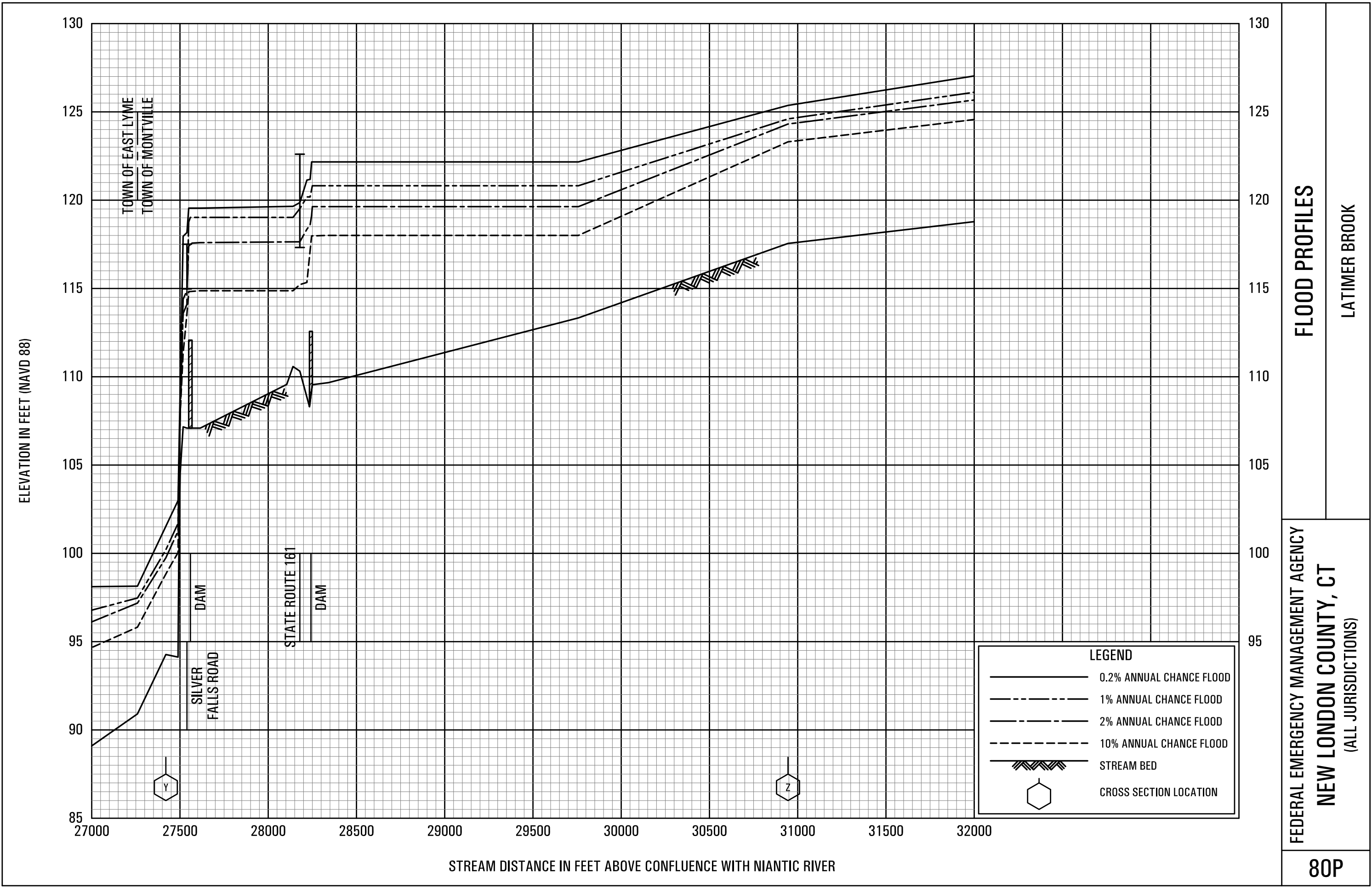
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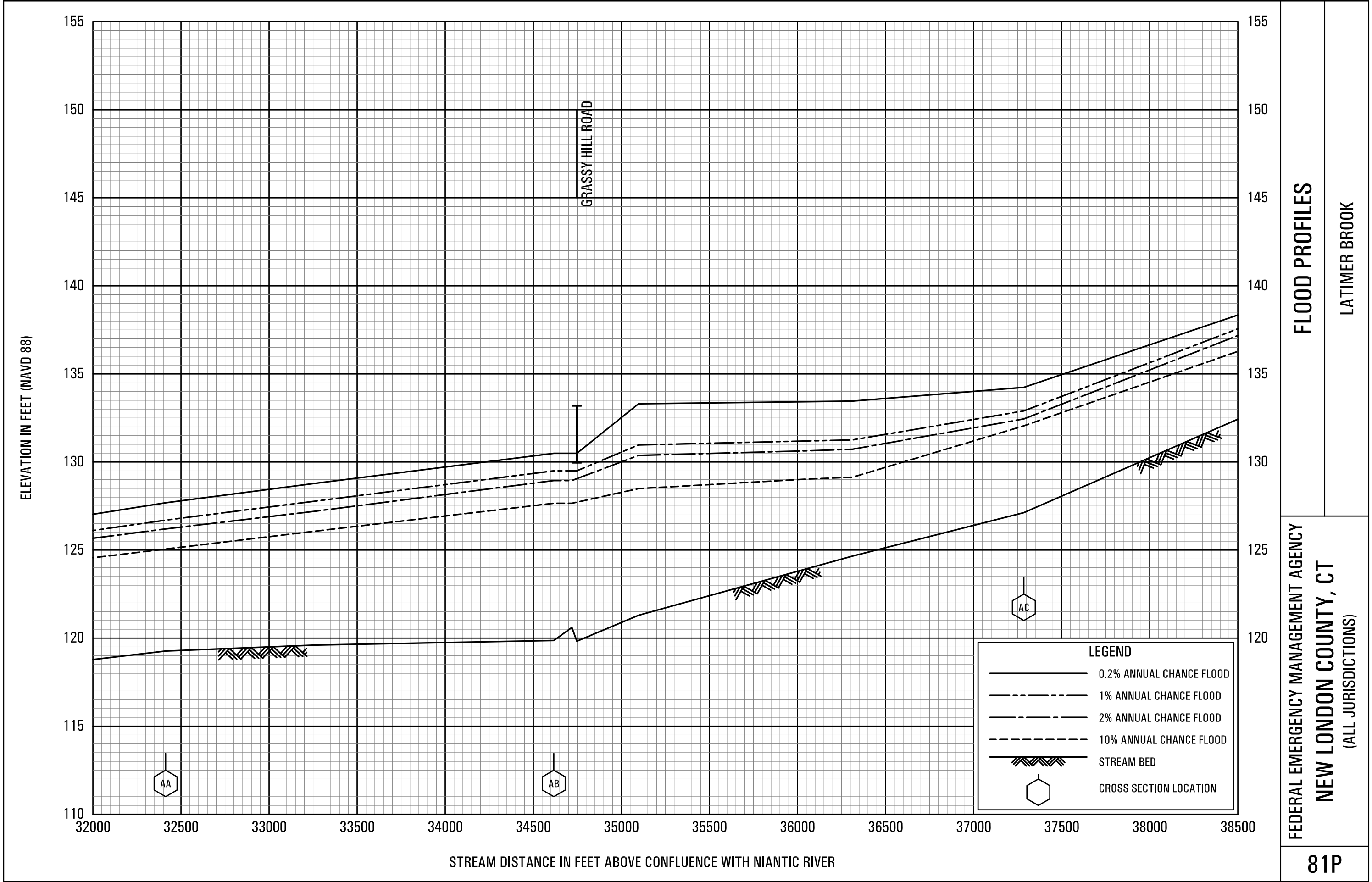
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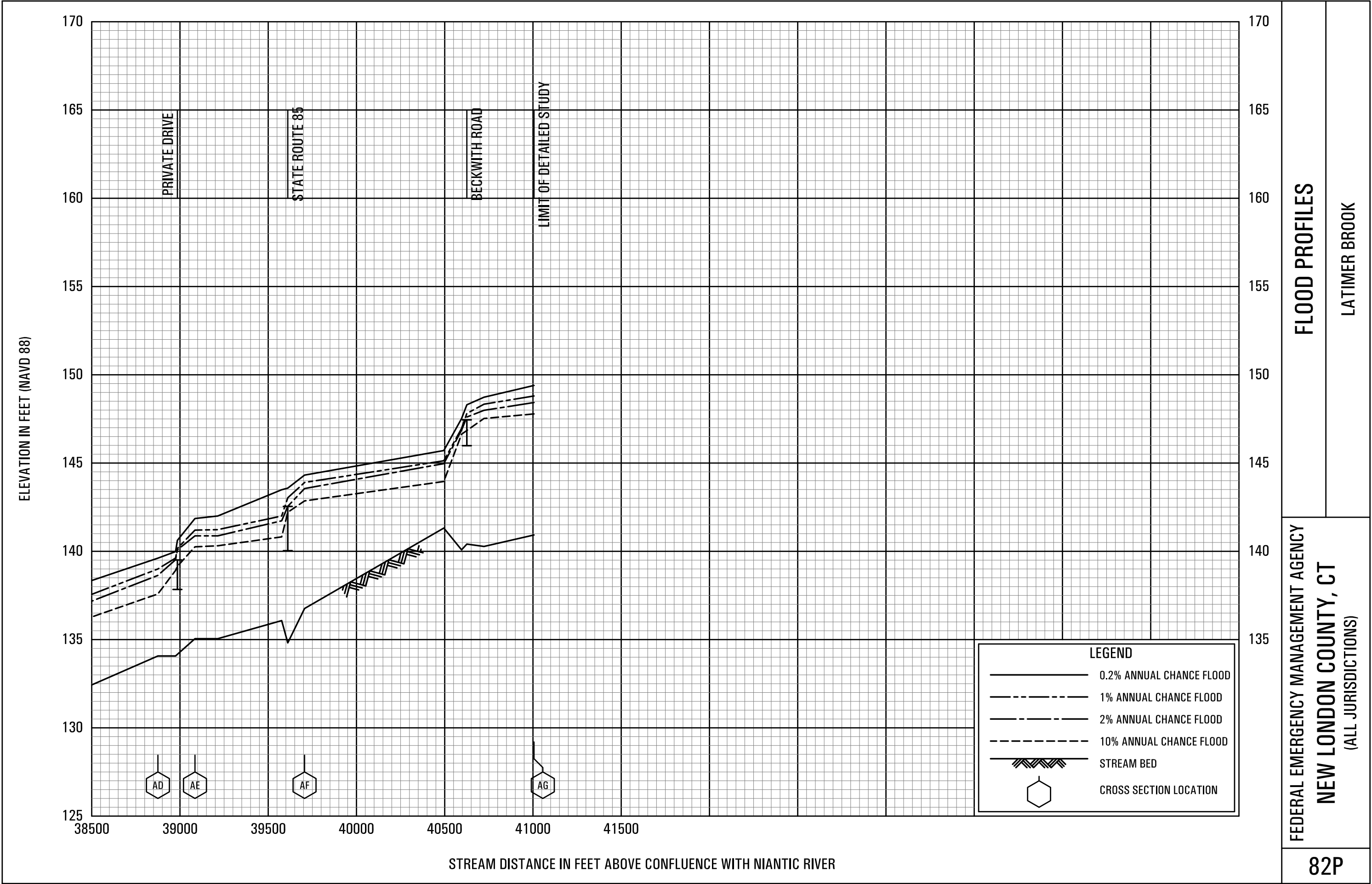
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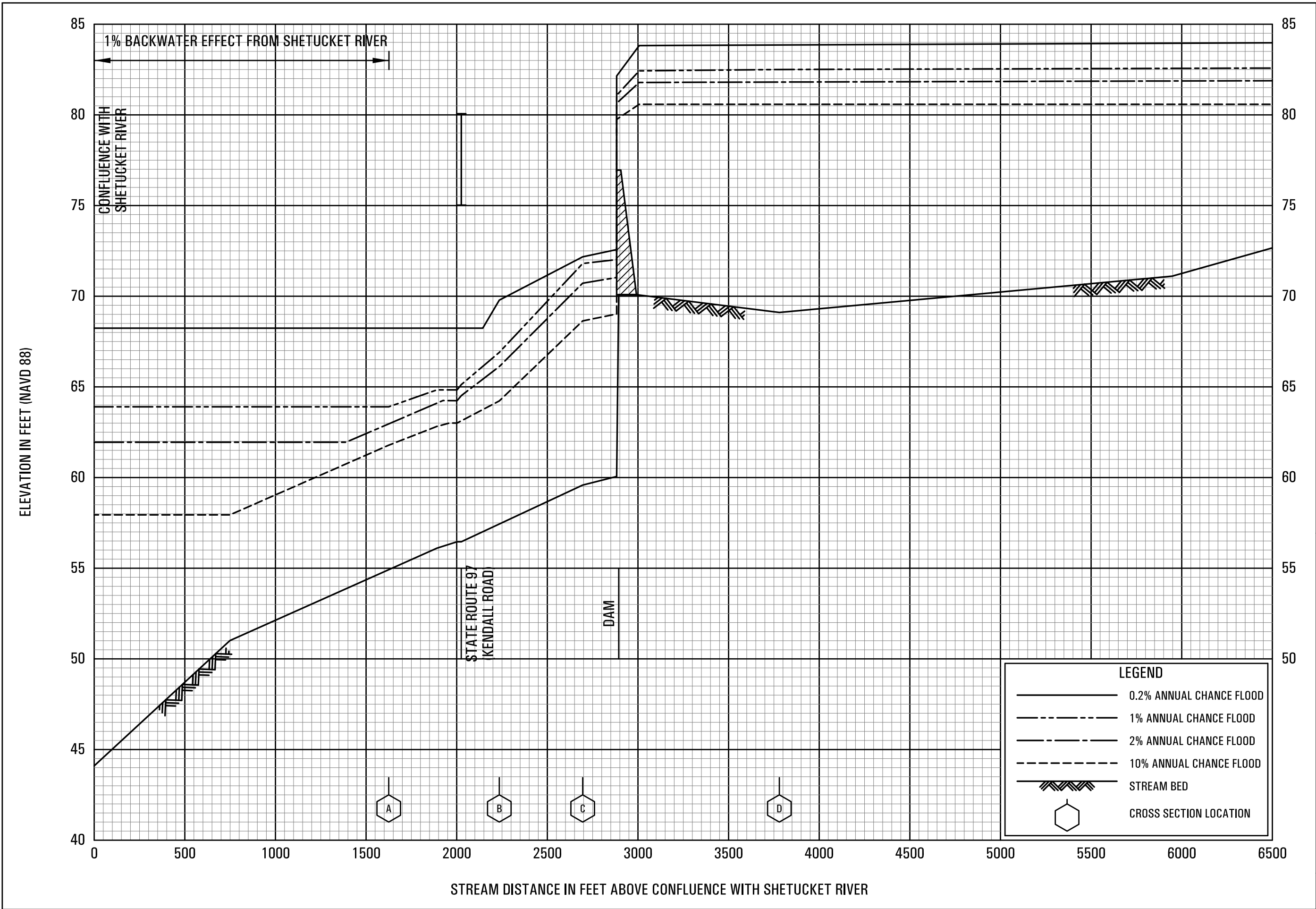
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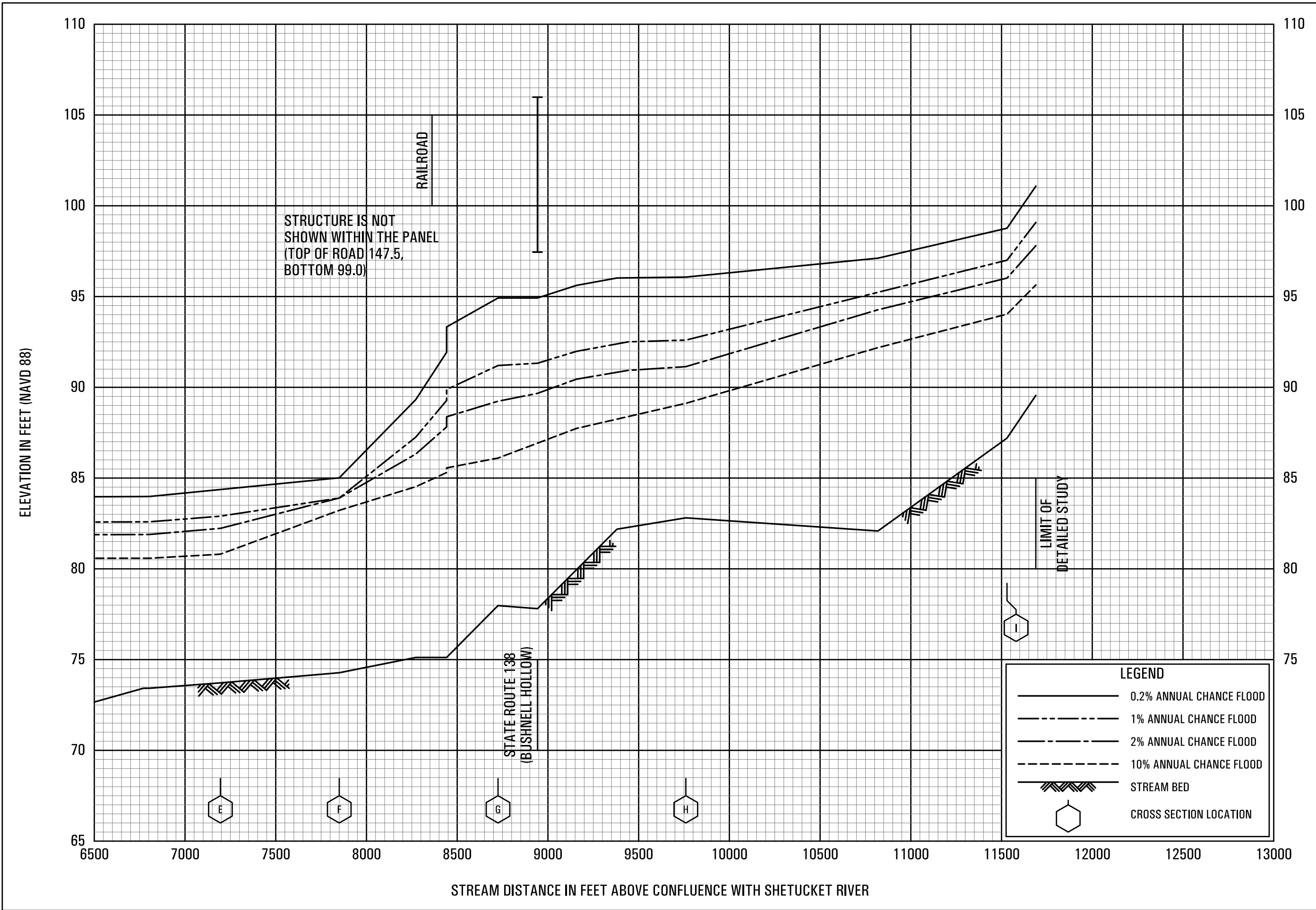


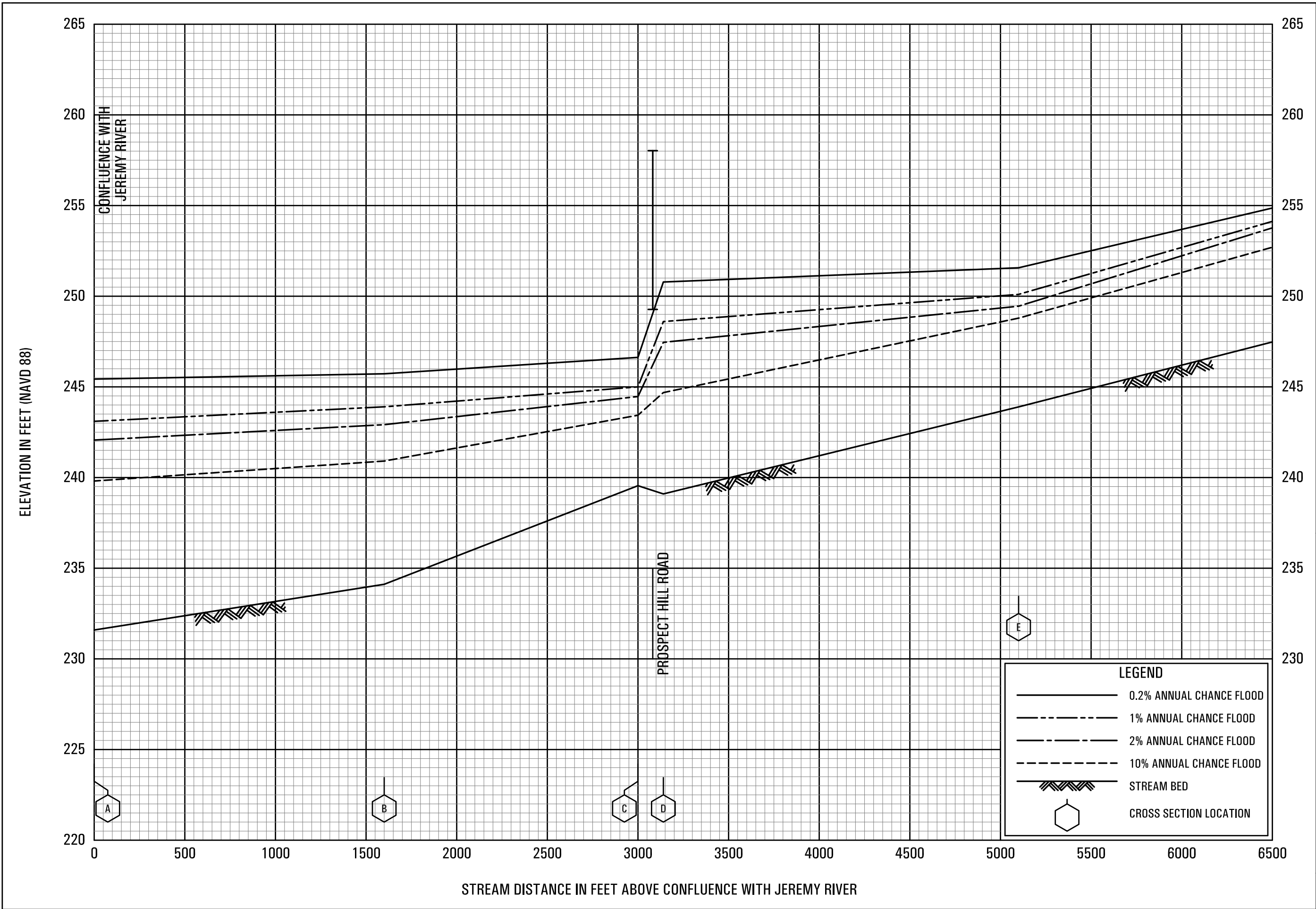


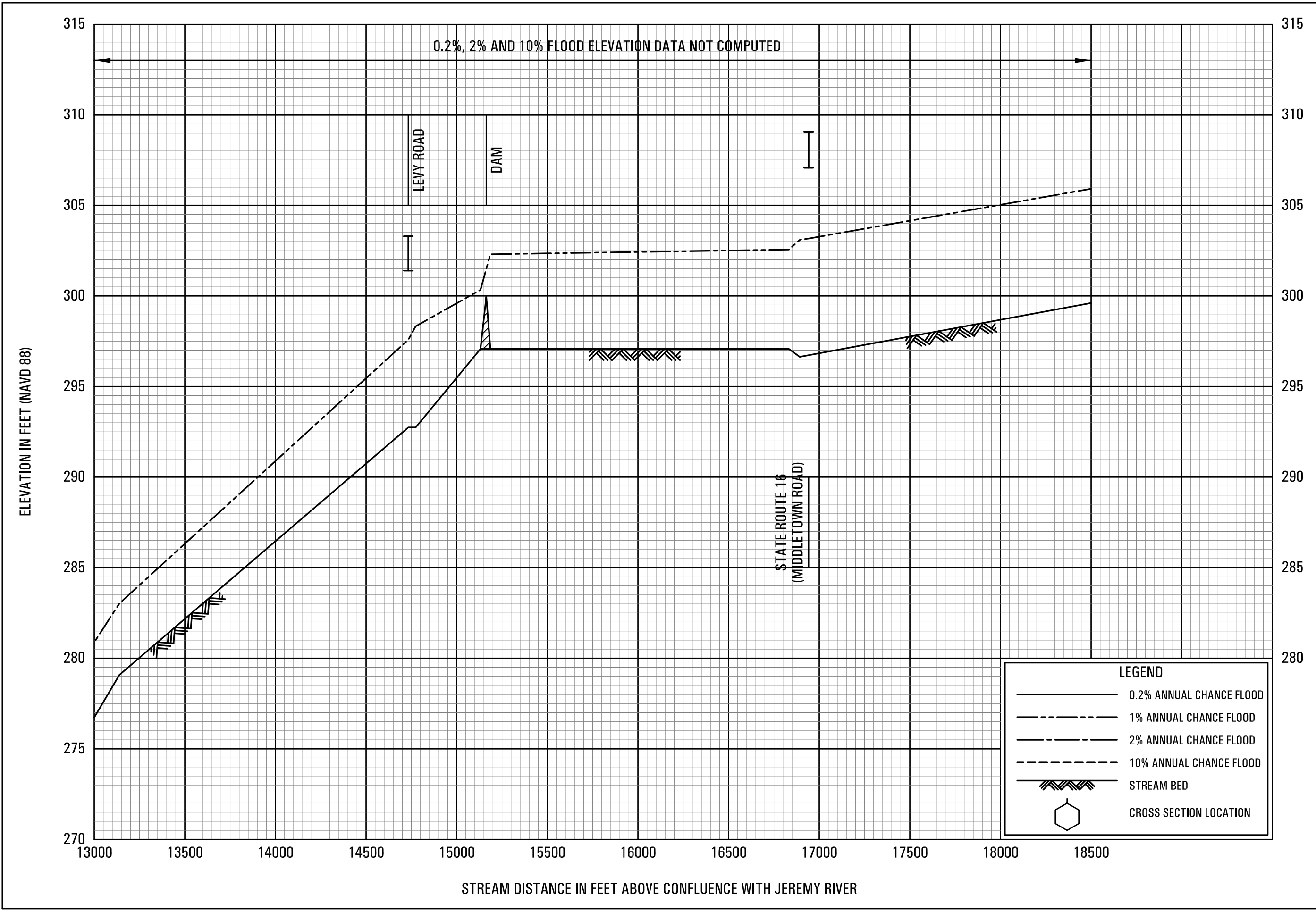


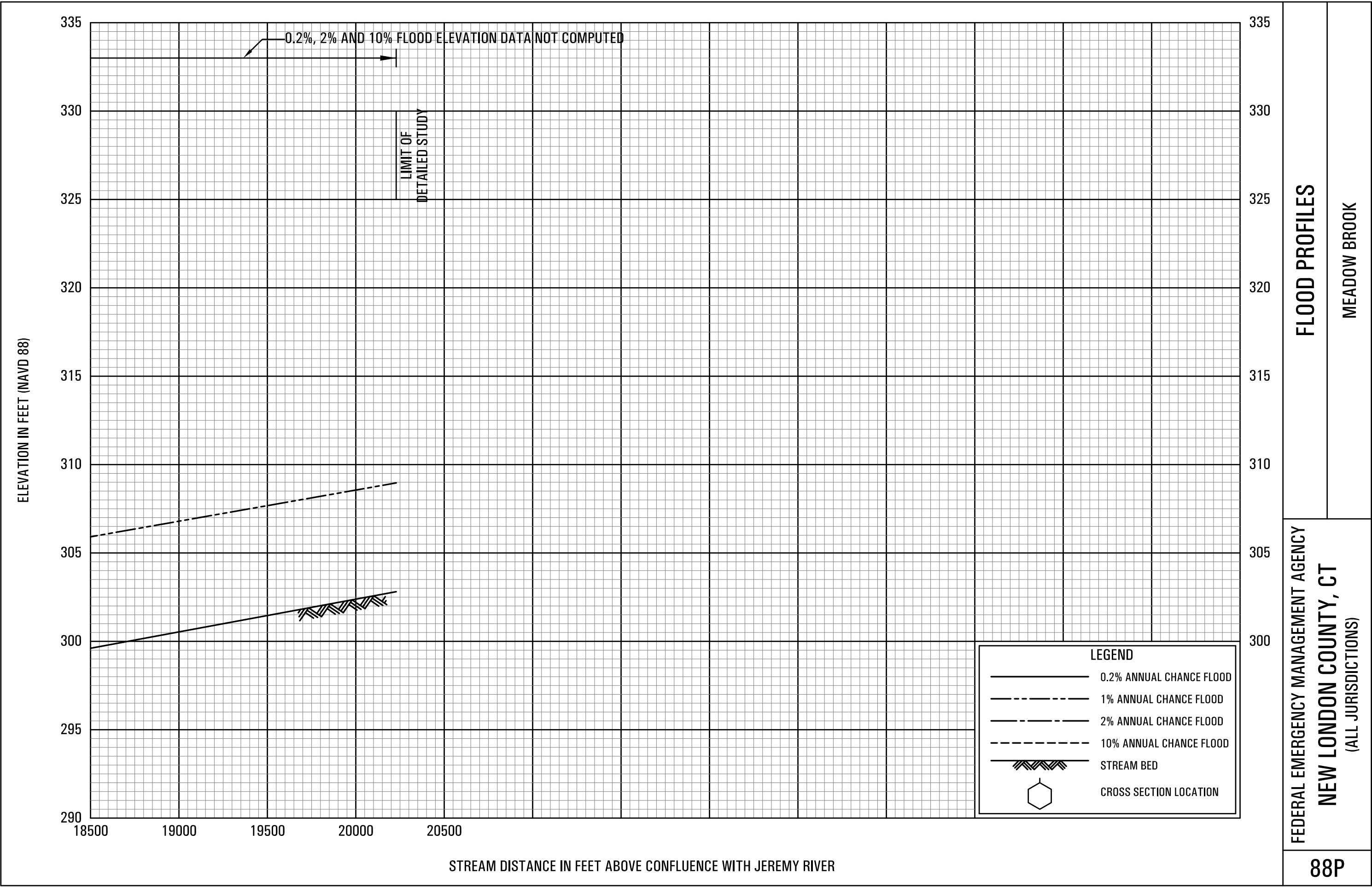


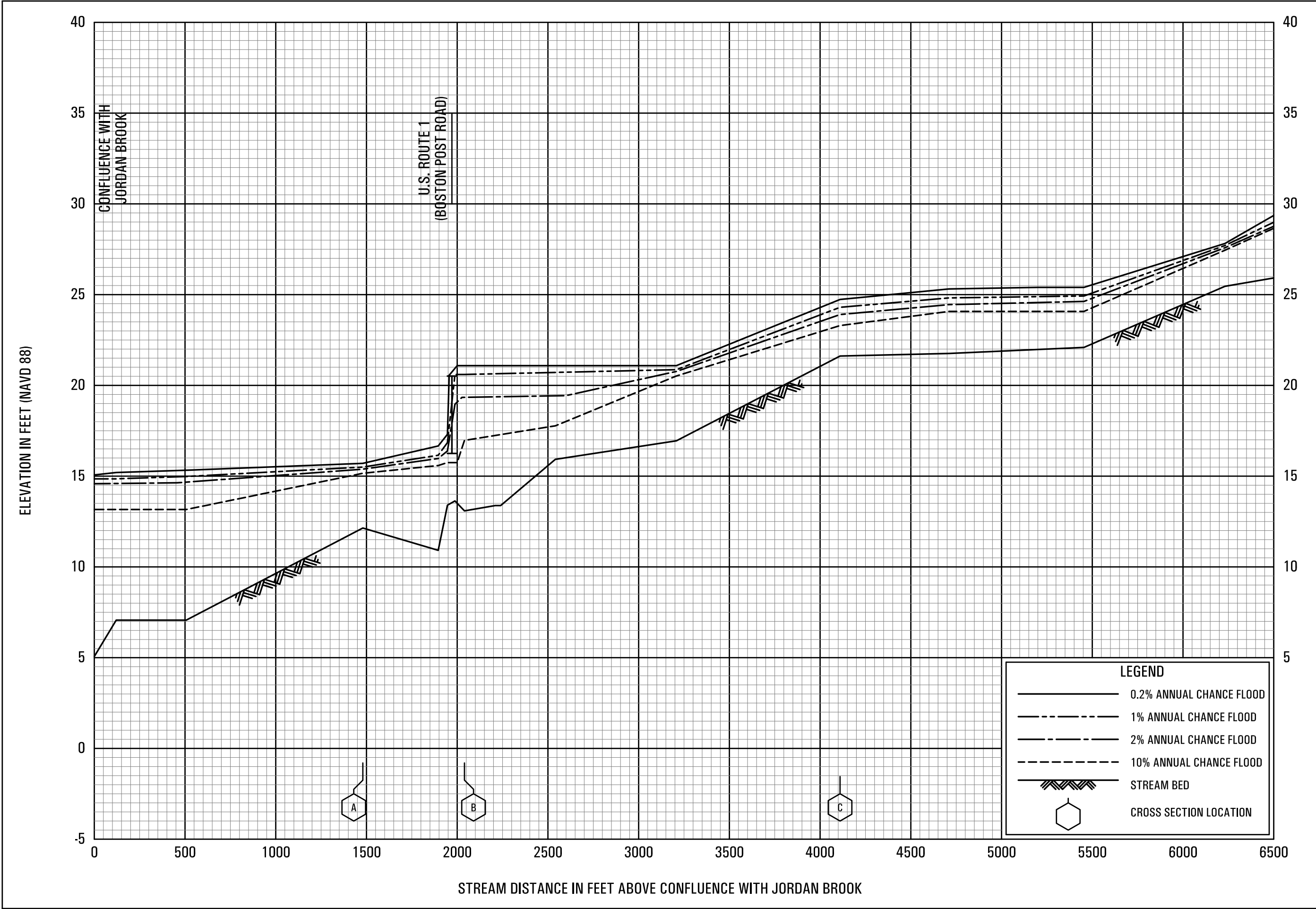


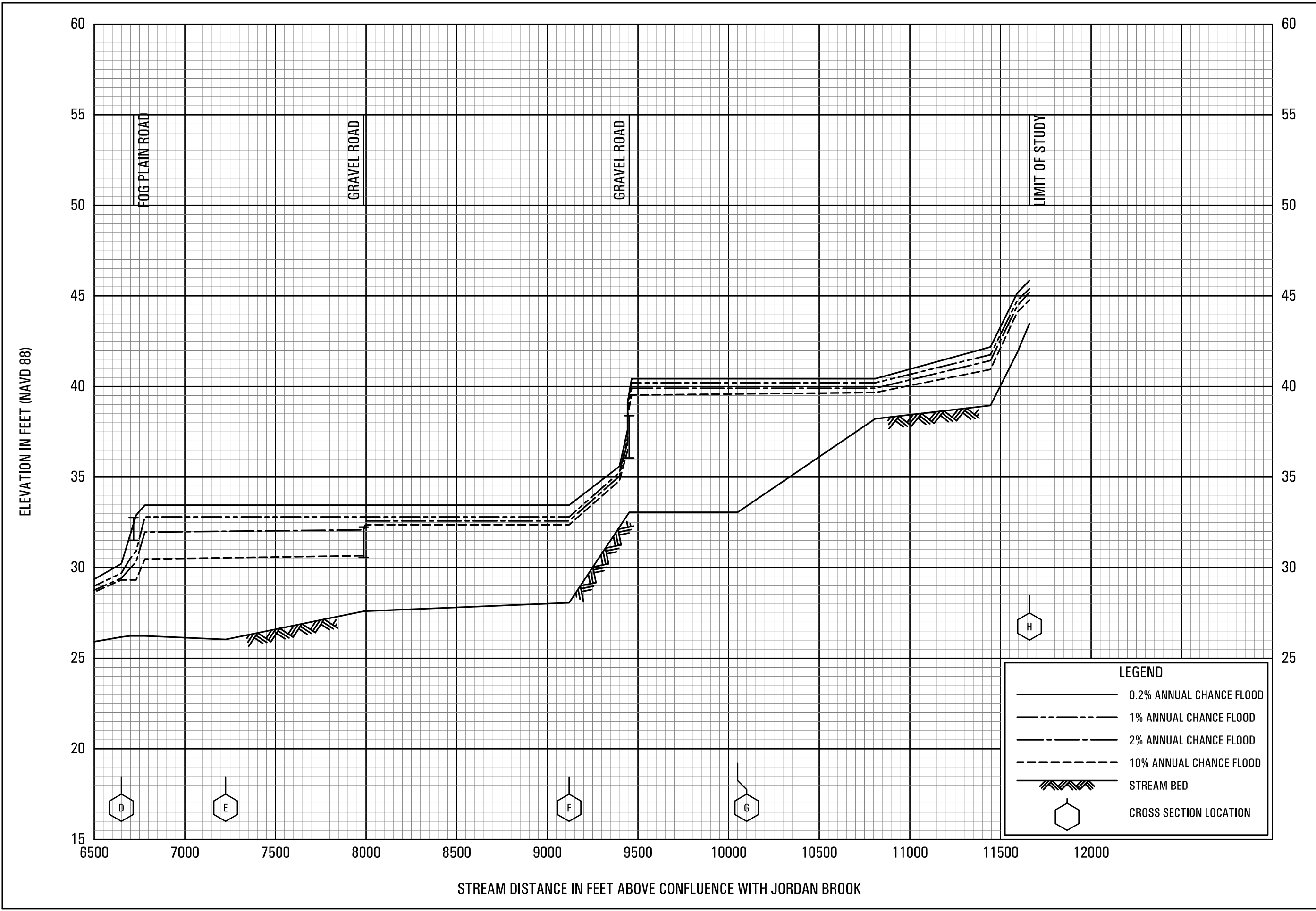


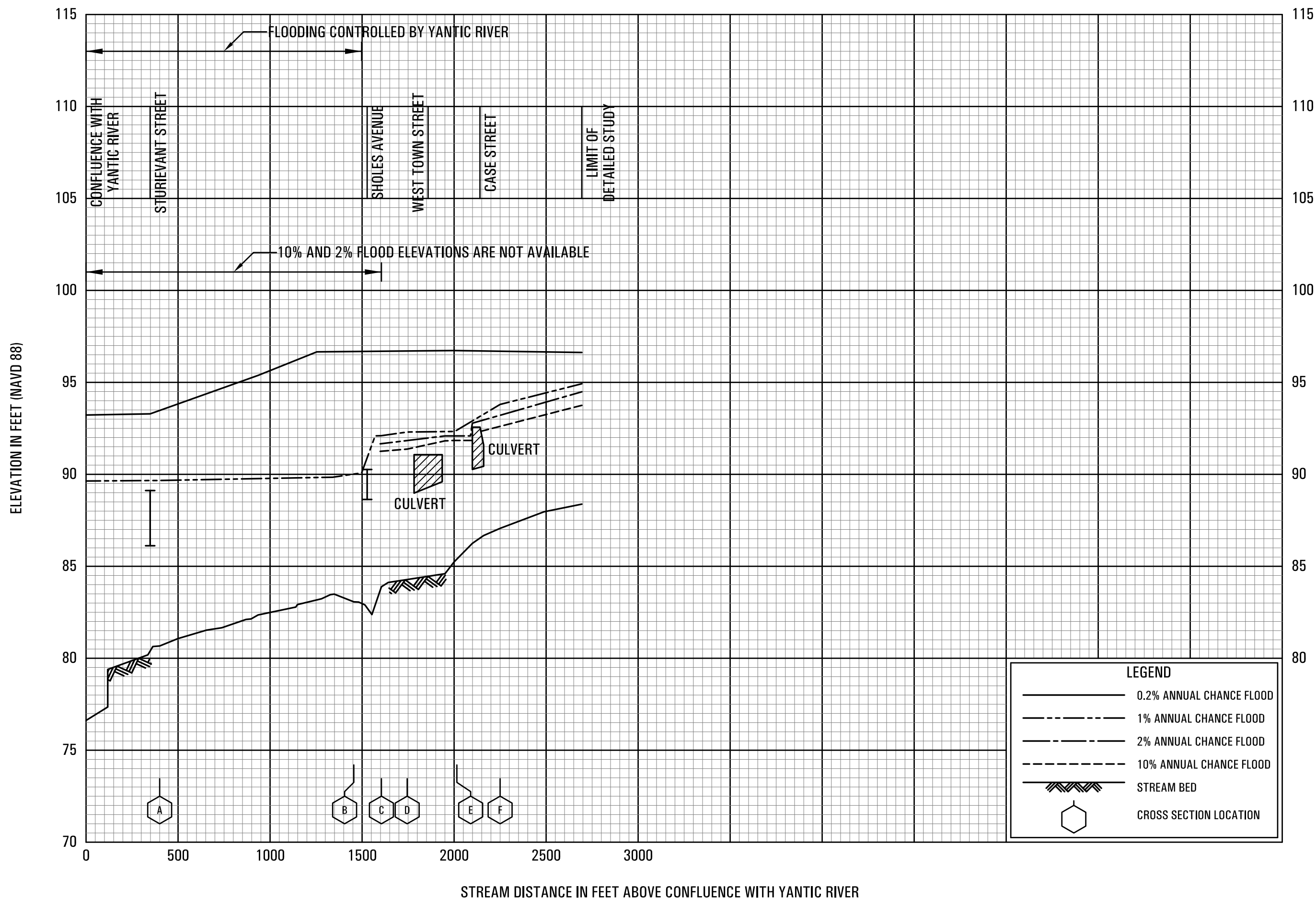












STREAM DISTANCE IN FEET ABOVE CONFLUENCE WITH YANTIC RIVER
