Waterford Senior Services Transportation:

Waterford Senior Services provides curb to curb transportation to Waterford Senior residents and residents with disabilities to medical appointments, shopping, errands, hair/barber appointments, town programs and to the Waterford Community Center. In order to access transportation, Waterford Seniors must complete a transportation form with our office. This form may be mailed or emailed and returned before transportation services may commence.

Scheduling is based on availability so it is important for riders to reserved their time far in advance of any appointments.

Seniors should be ready up to 1 hour BEFORE their appointment for pick up and they are instructed on how the service works at the time of their scheduling.

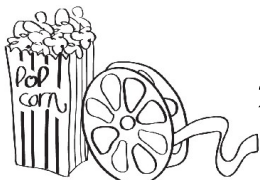

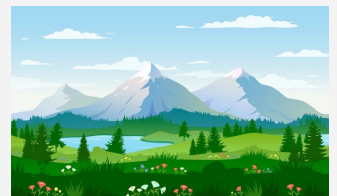

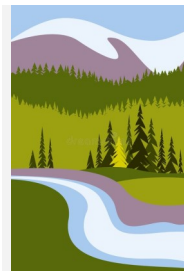
