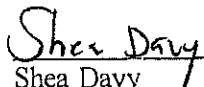
Dear Mr. Brule:

Proposals for the above mentioned project were opened on October 24, 2023 by Paul Koelle, Municipal Facilities Manager, and I with the attached results. After careful review of the proposal, reference checks and checking with the State, Department of Administrative Services, it is determined that Ahova Home Improvement, is the lowest qualified bidder with the resources necessary to complete this project.

I therefore respectfully seek the Board's approval to award the contract to Ahova Home Improvement in the amount of \$229,746.00. This would include the bid award of \$205,831.00 in addition to the add alternatives for composite exterior trim of \$20,145 and the 30 year warranty totaled at \$3,700.

There is also a request to reserve \$25,000 for the replacement of rotted wood roof deck, 10% contingency in the amount of \$22,000 of the contract award, also a \$25,000 to be reserved for a proper inspection.

Funds will be available in line #31122-55893, \$44,317 Eugene O'Neil Roof Replacement. The rest of the funds will be available through ARPA in line #23507-58022, Eugene O'Neil Theater.

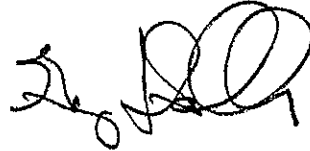

The Town received 3 bids for the Hammond Mansion Roof Replacement at the Eugene O'Neill Theater Center.

Paul Koelle from my office contacted the references and the answers were all positive. The contractors performed the work satisfactory. Checking with the State, Department of Administrative Services, none of the bidders are on the debarment list and all 3 are pre-qualified vendors in the State. The Architect's recommendation is to award to the highest bidder. They have worked with the highest bidder, but not the two lower bidders. In speaking with them, they have no problem working with any of the bidders.

The base bids were \$205,831, \$281,920 and \$435,000. The Architect's estimate was \$440,000. The Department had a concern going with any of the two lowest bids due the huge difference from the Architects estimate.

But based on the reference checks, that the lowest bidder have completed municipal work and done so satisfactorily, is not on the DAS Disbarment List and is a prequalified vendor in the State, it is the Department's recommendation that the contract to award to Ahova Home Improvement, LLC for the base bid of \$205,831 plus the Add Alternative 1 (Composite Exterior Trim) \$20,145 and Add Alternative 2 (30 year warranty) \$3,700.

We also recommend that reserved in the budget should be the following:

- \$25,000 for the replacement of rotted wood roof deck and plywood sheathing at the bidders stated price. (Assume worse case 5,000 sf x \$5/sf). Once the shingles and built up roof is removed, we will then know how much must be replaced. A change order will be issued increasing the contract based on the price found in the bid for such work.
- Contingency at 10% of the contract award \$22,000.
- I am also requesting \$25,000 be reserved for third party inspection. This will ensure that proper inspection of project can occur.

ARPA funds in the amount of \$301,676 should be reserved for this project.

Dear Mr. Brule,

I am writing to respectfully request that the Board of Selectmen reappoint me to another term on the Waterford Planning and Zoning Commission. My current term began November 19, 2018 and is due to expire on November 21, 2023. After our chairman, Gregory Massad, I am the second longest serving member of the Waterford Planning and Zoning Commission, and I believe this allows me to bring helpful institutional knowledge to our Commission. On several occasions, I have served as acting chairman when Mr. Massad was not able to attend a meeting. Additionally, I also have technical experience to offer to the Commission because, in my private practice as an attorney, I spend a great deal of my time working with municipal clients and on planning and zoning legal matters. In particular, I handle a great deal of zoning enforcement litigation for a neighboring town, and this experience has helped me to analyze the enforcement considerations of applications before the Commission as well as the enforcement challenges of proposed amendments to the Zoning Regulations. A significant part of my interest in reappointment is my desire to follow through on unfinished projects. For example, the Commission is presently engaged in writing the new Plan of Preservation, Conservation and Development (POCD). This is an important project for the future of our Town, and one that we began more than a year ago. Reappointment to the Commission would allow me to see the POCD project through to its conclusion as well as other unfinished matters before the Commission.

Additionally, as the Board may be aware, Sec. 9 of Public Act 21-29 requires all land use commissioners, such as members of the Planning and Zoning Commission, to complete at least four hours of training on certain land use topics by January 1, 2024. Thereafter, each Commissioner is required to take additional training every other year. The Town paid for me to take this training in March 2023, so I will not be required to take the training again until 2025. Although the cost to the Town for this training was not significant, it does represent an investment by the Town in qualifying me to sit on the Commission and I would like to make good on this investment by continuing to serve on the Commission. If a new Commissioner was appointed in my place, the new Commissioner would need to repeat my training much sooner.

Please let me know if there is any information that I can provide to the Board that would assist in its consideration of my request.

CGS Sec. 7-479d, Municipal Agent for the Youth

An interlocal risk management agency may sue or be sued and shall appoint a natural person residing in this state or a corporation authorized to do business in this state as its agent for service of process and notify the insurance commissioner of such appointment.

CGS Sec. 7-127b Municipal Agent for the Elderly

Sec. 7-127b. Municipal agents for elderly persons. Responsibilities of Department of Social Services. (a) The chief elected official or the chief executive officer if by ordinance of each municipality shall appoint a municipal agent for elderly persons. Such agent shall be a member of the municipality's commission on aging, if any, a member of another agency that serves elderly persons, an elected official of the state or the municipality or a responsible resident of the municipality who has demonstrated an interest in the elderly or has been involved in programs in the field of aging.

(b) Each municipal agent shall (1) disseminate information to elderly persons and assist such persons in learning about the community resources available to them and publicize such resources and benefits; (2) assist elderly persons in applying for federal and other benefits available to such persons; (3) submit written reports at least annually to the chief elected official, chief executive officer, legislative body and committee or commission on aging of the municipality, if any, and to the Department of Social Services on the services they have provided, the needs and problems of the elderly and any recommendations for municipal action with regard to elderly persons.

(c) Each municipal agent shall serve for a term of two or four years, at the discretion of the appointing authority of each municipality, and may be reappointed. If more than one agent is necessary to carry out the purposes of this section, the appointing authority, in the discretion of such appointing authority, may appoint one or more assistant agents. The town clerk in each municipality shall notify the Department of Social Services immediately of the appointment of a new municipal agent. Each municipality may provide to its municipal agent resources sufficient for such agent to perform the duties of the office.

(d) The Department of Social Services shall be responsible for assuring that the

provisions of this section are being carried out by municipalities, and shall adopt and disseminate to municipalities guidelines as to the role and duties of municipal agents and such informational and technical materials to assist such agents in performance of their duties. Said department shall provide training for municipal agents in accordance with their needs and the resources of the department and in cooperation with area agencies on aging. The department shall sponsor at least one training session in each of the planning and service areas of the Department of Social Services. Such training shall include, but not be limited to, information, from updated lists, on the availability of housing. Each municipal agent shall attend at least one such session. Said department shall assist such agents to develop and maintain simple records about the needs of elderly persons and the services provided to them, which records shall be confidential and used only to provide data that is useful to the Department of Social Services and the area agencies on aging in the preparation of the annual state and area plans.

(1972, P.A. 70; P.A. 77-447; P.A. 85-459, S. 1, 2; P.A. 88-206, S. 2; P.A. 93-262, S. 1, 87; P.A. 95-77; P.A. 01-195, S. 105, 181.)

History: P.A. 77-447 replaced all former provisions re municipal agents for disseminating information to elderly with more detailed provisions of Subsecs. (a) to (d), inclusive; P.A. 85-459 amended Subsec. (b) to require written reports to be submitted to the state department on aging and amended Subsec. (c) to require the town clerk to notify the state department on aging of the appointment of a new municipal agent; P.A. 88-206 gave the chief elected official the authority to appoint a municipal agent and provided that the chief executive officer may also appoint if by ordinance he is given such authority in Subsec. (a), made a technical change in Subsec. (b) and required the department on aging to sponsor at least one training session and specified that the training shall include information re the availability of housing and required each municipal agent to attend at least one session in Subsec. (d); P.A. 93-262 authorized substitution of department of social services for department on aging, effective July 1, 1993; P.A. 95-77 amended Subsec. (c) to allow a municipal agent to serve a term of two or four years, at the discretion of the appointing authority, where previously terms were two years only; P.A. 01-195 made technical changes, effective July 11, 2001.

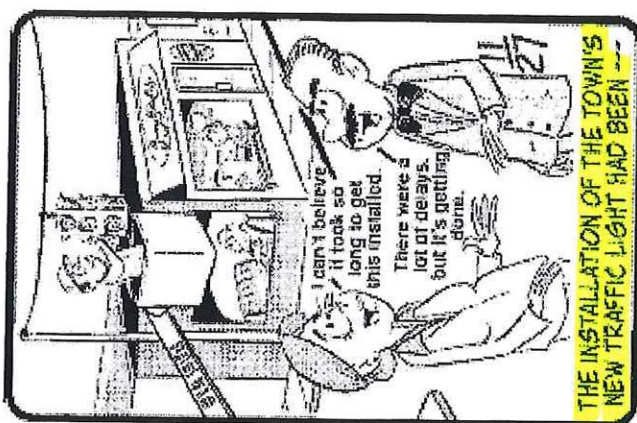
