- ☒ Upland soil types and delineation's based upon the Soil Survey of New London County or field identified by a soil scientist.
- ☒ Existing and proposed buildings, roads, utility lines, sanitary systems, and significant man-made or topographic features on or adjacent to the site.
- ☒ Flood Hazard Area classification and delineation.
- ☒ North arrow.
- ☒ Proposed clearing limits.
- ☒ All watercourses shall be shown.
- ☒ Detailed erosion and sediment and stormwater control plan, which meets or exceeds the minimum requirements as set forth in the 2002 CT guidelines for erosion and sediment control. The plan shall include the following information at a minimum.
- ☒ Location of areas to be cleared of vegetation and other exposed or unprotected areas.
- ☒ Location, design, timing, and method of installation of structural and non-structural sediment and stormwater control measures.
- ☒ Timing and description of all major phases of activity, installation of sediment and stormwater control measures, and temporary and permanent stabilization methods.
- ☒ Emergency provisions for failure of sediment or stormwater control devices and accidental spillage.
