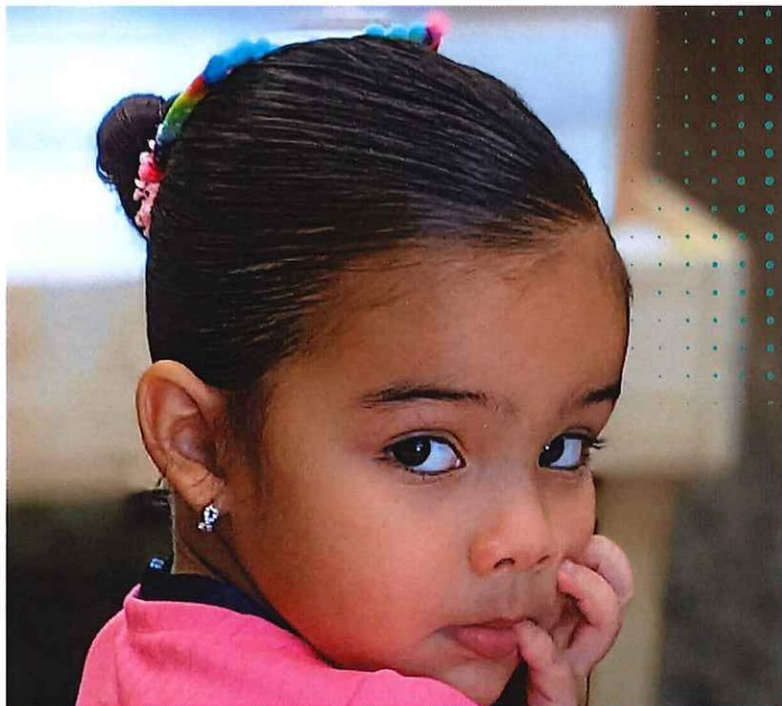

Re-imagining the Region's Early Childhood Magnet School

LEARN will:

- Invest in the Daniels Avenue neighborhood by designing outdoor learning spaces and recreational activities with fully accessible playgrounds
 - Town residents may use the outdoor learning spaces, activities, and playgrounds during non-school hours.
- Increase property values with a state-of-the-art early learning center
 - The facility will include indoor spaces for town residents to use during non-school hours.

LEARN seeks a permanent location for the region's youngest learners. At the 51 Daniels Avenue property in Waterford, LEARN will:

- Offer Waterford and the region access to a high-quality, multicultural, multilingual, educational program
 - 600 children (approximately), ages 6 weeks to 7 years
- Re-establish the 51 Daniels Avenue site as a well-respected school
- Assume all financial responsibility for the demolition of and environmental cleanup of the currently shuttered property

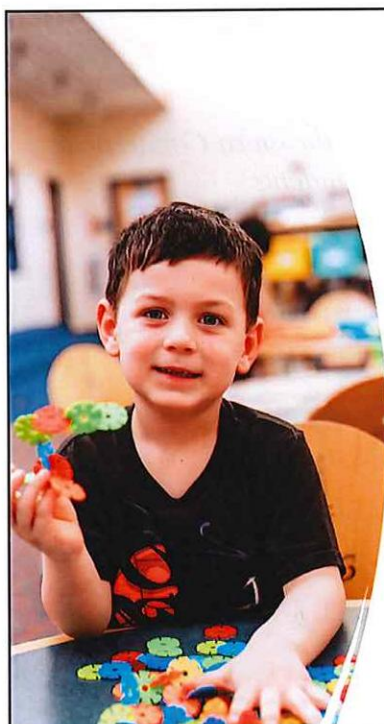

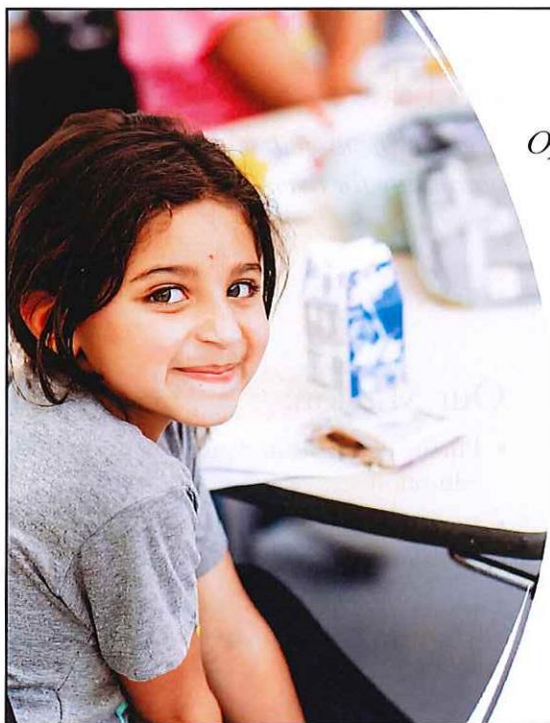

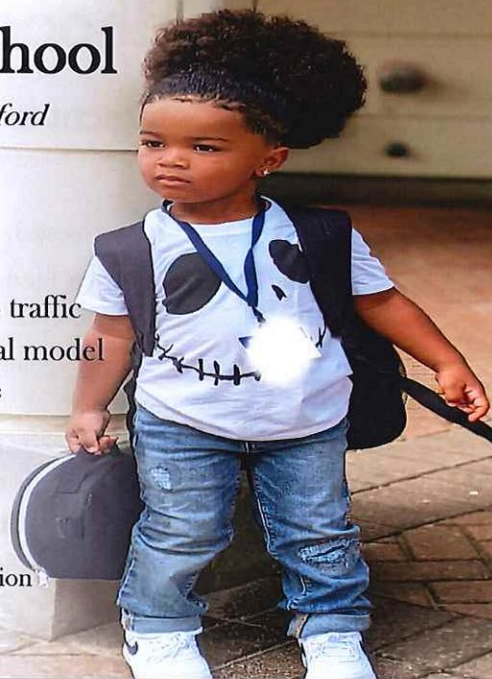
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Early Childhood Magnet School

Challenges

- Leased building [2025 expiration]
- Safety concerns on the school's current campus due to traffic
- Unsustainable pre-kindergarten magnet school financial model
 - Tuition based on parent/caregiver income and capped by the State of Connecticut
- Changed educational landscape
 - A childcare desert [quality care for children under age 3]
 - Pre-kindergarten now offered by area school districts
 - An increased need for the region's youngest special education students

Opportunity

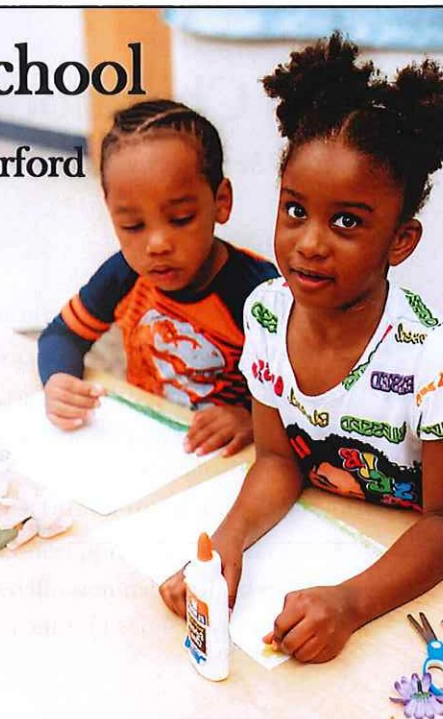
- Permanent location where LEARN can continue to serve the region
 - Fulfill LEARN's mission by operating high-quality, integrated schools
 - Offer Waterford and the region access to a high-quality, multicultural, multilingual educational program
 - 600 children [approximately], ages 6 weeks to 7 years
 - Regional special education programming

- Re-establish the site as a well-respected, integrated school
