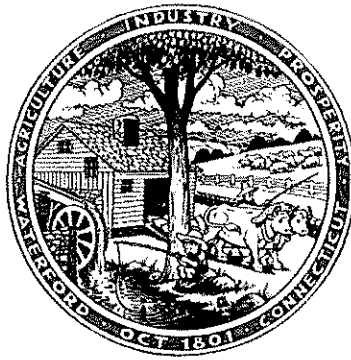




**Town of Waterford, Connecticut Police Commission

NEW BUSINESS

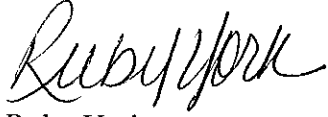
- a. End of year line item transfers-

- d. Sgt. D Ferland did a presentation on the new Marijuana laws.

Commissioner Sheridan brought up speed bumps on Beach Rd. going down to the beach, he states that around 2 years ago it was voted on in a BOPC meeting and he would like this to be revisited and acted upon. There is a question as to who would pay for the speed bumps to be installed. R. Brule will follow up and report back to the commission.
