NEW BUSINESS

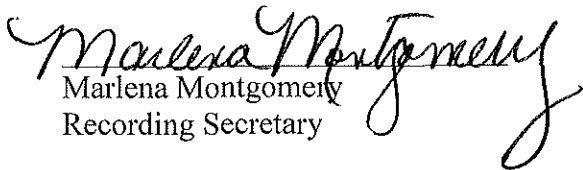
