LINE OF DUTY DEATH DETERMINATION COMMITTEE

1. Pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes § 7-313e, the Town of Waterford designates the following Committee to determine whether a firefighter or police officer died in the line of duty, as defined in § 7-313e:

- a. Director of Fire Services
- b. Police Chief
- c. Human Resources Director, or their designee.

2. In those circumstances where the determination, under § 7-313e, must be made, the Committee shall make the determination by majority vote. The Committee may request information needed to make the determination from the Department or an applicant.

3. In accordance with § 7-313e, the determination shall not be used as evidence for a workers' compensation claim.
